

## FARMINGTON CHASE ASSOCIATION POOL RULES & REGULATIONS – 2005 SEASON

The enjoyment of the pool and surrounding facilities is dependent on a high standard of sanitation and conduct. In addition to the following rules that were adopted in conformity with the requirements of the State Department of Public Health, all general clubhouse rules shall apply to the use of the swimming pool area, including the adjoining outside deck/patio:

### WEEKDAYS

10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. POOL ATTENDANT ON DUTY. Children 16 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult. (Until June 20<sup>th</sup>)

10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Beginning June 21<sup>st</sup> – POOL ATTENDANT ON DUTY. Children 16 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

### WEEKENDS

10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. POOL ATTENDANT ON DUTY Children 16 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

### EXTENDED HOURS

10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. September 7<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>.  
NO POOL ATTENDANT ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY **DO NOT** SWIM ALONE. Children 16 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent/adult.

### RULES

1. All persons enter the pool area and use the pool at their own risk. The Association will not be responsible for any accidents resulting from the use of the pool or surrounding facilities.

2. All persons **MUST** bring pool tags in order to be admitted to the pool area.

**The Association issues pool tags for each person living in your unit. If you have never received pool tags, call Imagineers, L.L.C. If you lost your pool tags, Imagineers, L.L.C. will issue new ones for a fee of \$2.00/tag. Renters obtain tags from your landlord.**

Guests without tags are welcome to use the pool when accompanied and signed in by the adult homeowner or adult resident. If the pool is crowded however, you will be requested, at the discretion of the pool attendant, to have your guests leave.

3. Use of the pool after it has been padlocked for the day is hazardous and will not be tolerated. Residents caught using the pool after hours will be fined \$100.00. Non-residents will be prosecuted.

4. Small children should be under close supervision at all times. Do not allow them to wander near the edge of the pool

**Children under 16 years of age, without the supervision of an adult over 18 will be asked to leave. This is for your child's safety and protection.**

5. There will be adequate adult swimming periods starting on the hour. Parents are asked to cooperate during this time keeping children out of the pool. This includes dangling feet, horseplay, etc.
6. For health reasons, persons with any communicable diseases, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections or anyone whose physical condition could endanger the health of others shall restrict themselves to the pool area and shall be excluded from the pool. No spitting or blowing your nose is allowed in the pool.
7. All swimmers, must shower with soap and warm water before entering the pool. Prolonged use of or playing with the showers is prohibited.
8. Babies must wear disposable diapers designed for swimming or they will not be allowed in the pool.
9. Adults must wear proper swimming attire. No street clothing, cut-off jeans, thongs, or pants are allowed for swimming purposes.
10. Throwing foreign matter and debris into the pool or about the pool area is not allowed. Please use the trash containers.
11. No pets are allowed in the pool area (with the exception of animals for the hearing, sight, or physically impaired).
12. Food consumption must be restricted to the deck of the clubhouse.
13. No glass items of any kind (other than eyeglasses) will be permitted inside the pool area.
14. Toys including beach balls, water pistols, and metallic objects are not allowed in the pool. Swim accessories may not be used unless approved by the pool attendant for children learning to swim or adults with special needs. These types of accessories must be attached to the individual by a safety strap or secured to the individual in a manner such as water wings. It is imperative to note that the accessories mentioned above will not include swim boards, noodles, floats, tubes, etc... if they do not include a safety strap.

15. No diving into the pool will be permitted. No jumping into the pool is allowed by the steps or near someone in the water. Running, spitting, undue splashing, horseplay, fighting or obscene language is allowed in the pool area.

Abuse of pool furniture and other property will not be tolerated. Radios, cassette and compact disc (cd) players may be played through earphones only.

Infraction of these behavior rules (#15) will result in:

- First infraction - restriction from the pool for one day.
- Second infraction - restriction from the pool for the rest of the season.

**The pool attendant has the right to discipline people from the pool for actions considered unfit.**

16. The Board of Directors shall interpret these rules.

### **GUESTS**

- ❑ Residents are responsible for their guests at all times.
- ❑ Guests are not to swim unless there is a paid pool attendant present and on duty.
- ❑ Per the Bylaws: Guests without tags are welcome to use the pool when accompanied and signed in by the homeowner or resident. If the pool is crowded, however, you may at the discretion of the pool attendant, be limited to a maximum of two (2) guests.

### **SMOKING**

Smoking will not be allowed in the pool area. A bench will be placed outside the fenced area and provided with ashtrays for smokers.
